

Alphabet Board

This is a communication aid to help people who either cannot talk or have speech that is difficult to understand.

Put the communication aid on a stable surface in front of the person.

Ask the person to point to the letters to spell out what they want.

The Alphabet Board is a communication aid consisting of a central grid of letter tiles and several control buttons. The central grid is arranged as follows:

- Row 1: 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 0
- Row 2: Q W E R T Y U I O P
- Row 3: A S D F G H J K L
- Row 4: Z X C V B N M ?

Control buttons are located on the left and right sides of the board:

- Left Side (Red and Blue buttons):**
 - No** (Red button)
 - Can you write it down** (Blue button)
 - It starts with...** (Blue button)
 - I'd like to ask you something** (Blue button)
 - Do you understand** (Blue button)
- Right Side (Green and Blue buttons):**
 - Yes** (Green button)
 - End of word** (Blue button)
 - I made a mistake I'll start again** (Blue button)
 - Please get the Library word board** (Blue button)
 - Thanks** (Blue button)
